FUTSAL RULES | July 14th 2023 (Friday)

The Field

The game of Futsal is played on a marked field and the ball can go out of play.

The Ball

Given that Futsal is played on a smaller field, which emphasizes skills and passing, the game is played with a smaller ball that has 30% less bounce than a standard soccer ball.

Offside Rule

There is no offside rule in Futsal.

Rotating Substitutions

Up to 10 players can be used in a match and there is no limit on how long a player must stay on the field, nor is a stoppage required for player substitutions, which are permitted during play.

Kick-Ins

In order to re-start the game after the ball has gone out of play, the ball is kicked back into play from the touchline and from corners. The ball must be placed stationary in the line.

The 4 Second Rule

For kick-ins, free kicks, goal clearances and corner kicks, the player in possession of the ball has 4 seconds to restart play which the referee will count with fingers in the air. If play is not restarted within 4 seconds an indirect kick will be awarded to the opposing team. The goalkeeper is not allowed to control the ball for more than 4 seconds in his/her own half.

The 6 Feet Rule

Players are required to keep 6 feet from the player in possession of the ball on corners and kick-ins

Goalkeepers

Goalkeepers are allowed to come out of the penalty area and players are allowed to go into the penalty area. A goal clearance must be thrown (and not kicked) and the goalkeeper cannot touch the ball again in his midfield until a member of the opposing team has touched the ball. However, the goalkeeper has no restrictions in the opponent's midfield.

Accumulated Fouls

Each team is allowed to commit 5 faults during each part of a game. On the 6th foul, a direct kick is awarded to the opposing team and the offending team is not allowed to position any players (other than the goalkeeper)

between the ball and the goal. The kick may be taken from the 10 meter (32.5 foot) mark, or if the foul was committed closer to the goal than the 10M/32.5ft mark then the kick may be taken.

Game Time

A match will consist of 30 minutes of play: 15 minutes each half, separated by a maximum of 5 minutes break.

Time Outs

Each team is allowed one 30-second timeout per each half of the game.

Time out must be requested to the referee.

Sliding Tackling

Sliding tackles are not allowed in Futsal but players are allowed to slide on the field (e.g., to stop a ball from going out of play, to direct a pass towards the net, etc.) For a player sliding to be considered a foul, the tackler's opponent must be in possession of the ball. Referees will not give a foul for a slide if the opponent does not have possession of the ball.

Group Phase

The group phase tournament match will be based on the following scoring:

- Win: 3 points
- Tie: 1 point
- Loss: 0 points

Group Phase - Tie Breaker

If two or more teams in the same group are equal on points, the following criteria is applied, in the order given, to determine the rankings:

1. Direct confrontation result
2. Superior goal difference in all matches
3. Higher number of goals scored in all matches

Play Offs - Tie Breaker

In case of a tie into the playoffs match, 3 penalties for each team must be performed. Wins the team who scored more penalty kicks. If a tie persists, the penalty kicks will continue, without repeating players, until the tie is broken.

Awards

There will be awards to the TOP 3 teams.

Play-offs

- Unlike the Futsal tournament, we will have only a quarter-finals, semi-finals and final play-offs happening in the Beach Soccer.

BEACH SOCCER RULES | July 15th 2023 (Saturday)

Game Time

A match is divided into two periods with a length of ten (10) minutes each, divided by one five- minute break.

Rotating Substitutions

Up to 10 players can be used in a match and there is no limit on how long a player must stay on the field, nor is a stoppage required for player substitutions, which are permitted during play.

Offside Rule

There is no offside rule in Beach Soccer.

Goalkeepers

Goalkeepers can move freely around the penalty area with the ball in their hands. This area is marked out by a horizontal line across the field.

They have four seconds to get the ball into play, which they can only do so by using their hands.

They cannot score this way or by kicking the ball out on the volley.

The goalkeeper cannot receive (grab/touch) the ball from a team-mate a second time until it touches an opponent.

Kick-Ins

In order to re-start the game after the ball has gone out of play, the ball is kicked back into play from the touchline and from corners. The ball must be placed stationary in line or thrown in with hands. In this last case, both feet must be in the line when throwing the ball.

Free-kicks: direct only

Every infraction of the rules is sanctioned with a direct free-kick, with no wall permitted!

It is taken from the spot where the foul was committed, except in the cases of penalty kicks (taken from the penalty spot).

In the case of foul play, the kick must be taken by the player who was fouled – unless injury prevents this. The player has 4 seconds to play the ball after the referee's whistle.
